

HIV can be transmitted through sex without a condom. Condoms protect against HIV and other sexually transmitted diseases.





had condomless sex with at least one casual partner in the past 12 months. **24%** of participants received free condoms in the past 12 months.



Pre-exposure prophylaxis or PrEP is a pill that, taken daily, can protect someone from getting HIV. Of HIV negative heterosexuals interviewed:





< 1% reported ever taking PrEP.
