


HIV Infection, Risk, & Prevention among Persons Who Inject Drugs (PWID)

National HIV Behavioral Surveillance (NHBS)

Denver, 2015

4% of PWID were HIV-positive




Syringe sharing and disposal

33% used a syringe after someone else used it

39% gave someone a syringe after they used it

29% always disposed of their used syringes safely

Most frequently injected drug



38% were 18 years or younger when they first injected


32% were hooked on prescription opioids before they first injected

66% inject more than once a day

Overdose experiences and naloxone access

22% of PWID overdosed at least once and 53% witnessed an overdose in the past 12 months, but only 32% have a naloxone kit
