In **Denver, 433** sexually active gay, bisexual, and other men who have sex with men (MSM) were interviewed

Overall, about 1 in 10 were living with HIV

Among HIV-negative MSM, PrEP awareness was high, but usage was low

Overall Prep Awareness was 81% | Overall Prep Use was 34%

Pre-exposure prophylaxis (or PrEP) is a pill that, taken daily, **can protect someone from getting HIV.**


